Introduction

Sandown Carnival Association wishes to aid groups in developing their Carnival projects with the overall aim of improving the quality and appeal of our events.

What does the Carnival Development Fund cover?

Groups may apply for grants towards the cost of their carnival projects to cover materials, artist time, training, research and development, venue hire, rental costs, documentation, instruments etc..

The Application Process

Complete the two page application form and return it to **The Chairperson, Sandown Carnival Outlet, 77A High Street, Sandown PO36 8DA**. Applications **MUST** be returned by 4pm on **Friday 24th MAY 2019**. Successful applicants will be notified soon after the closing date. Late applications will **NOT** be assessed. E-mailed applications are not acceptable.

Who can apply?

Any not-for-profit group, school or community organisation who will be participating in **at least two** of the 3 main Sandown Carnival processions may apply. These are Children's Day (Friday July 26th), Main Carnival (Saturday July 27th) and Illuminated Carnival (Wednesday August 28th). If for any reason you are unable to attend at least two events, we reserve the right to seek an appropriate rebate.

How much is available?

Grants of **up to £250** will be considered and allocated to applicants selected by the assessment panel in line with the criteria set out below.

Assessment panel

The panel will consist of at least three elected officers of Sandown Carnival Association assisted by elected members. The assessment panel's decisions will be final and all applicants will receive constructive feedback.

Assessment criteria

We would be keen to aid groups who can evidence the following:

- How your project is being planned, managed and overseen
- How well your project builds on your group's previous participation in carnival adding a new dimension to your carnival involvement; if a new project how you feel it knits with current carnivals
- How well your project will enhance the quality and diversity of Sandown Carnival parades
- How your project applies itself to current cultural attitudes, reflecting our changing society

Above all, Sandown is a FUN carnival. If you are a happy smiley group you may get extra points!
