



A CARPET OF FLOWERS - from the people of PUENTEAREAS

PUENTEAREAS is situated on the road from Vigo to Madrid, 31km from the Atlantic coast in NW Spain. The magnificant climate in this area has made PUENTEAREAS a very important tourist centre. Added to this the beauty and the tranquillity of the surroundings, and the warmth of its people, which have stimulated many families from the south of the province to build their holiday homes in the area.

PUENTEAREAS is famous throughout Spain for its wonderful carpets of flowers which are made at the time of Corpus Christi, and which have given its name of 'The Town of Corpus Christi'. PUENTEAREAS has made three carpets over the years for Pope John II, including one in Saint Peters Square in the Vatican.

It is the great community spirit that drive the people on to the great self-imposed obligation of making its carpets, with one in charge it is amazing

co-ordination that gets the job done. Weeks beforehand, the places where flowers can be aquired are already located, in a tireless pilgrimage through fields and mountains. In every street, in every square, everyone comes together in the preparations, from the design, collecting of the flowers to the laying.

Here too at SANDOWN we invite you to join in the community spirit and come along to the pier and help with the laying of the flowers. The carpet will start at about 9am on Wednesday morning continuing through the day, hopefully with completion around 5pm that day. The carpet will remain in place over night for you to come along and view throughout Thursday. Also the people of PUENTEAREAS will be performing local folk dancing displays for you to enjoy.




