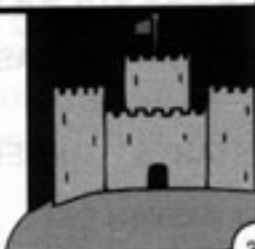

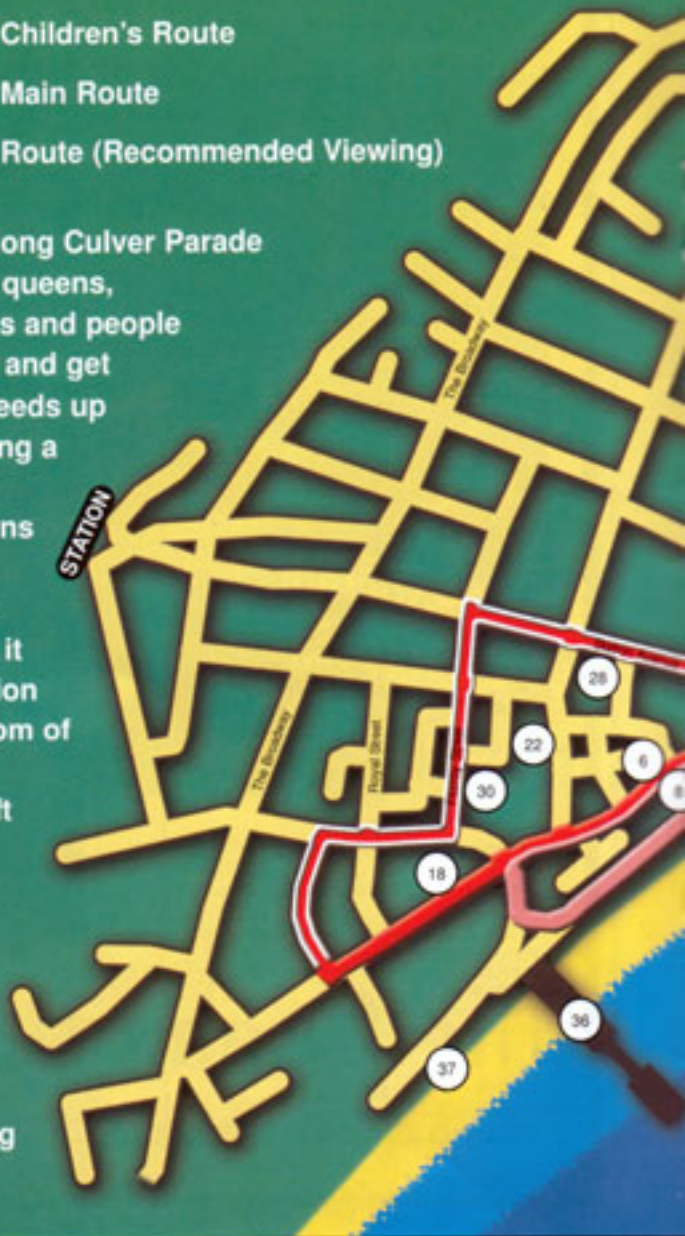

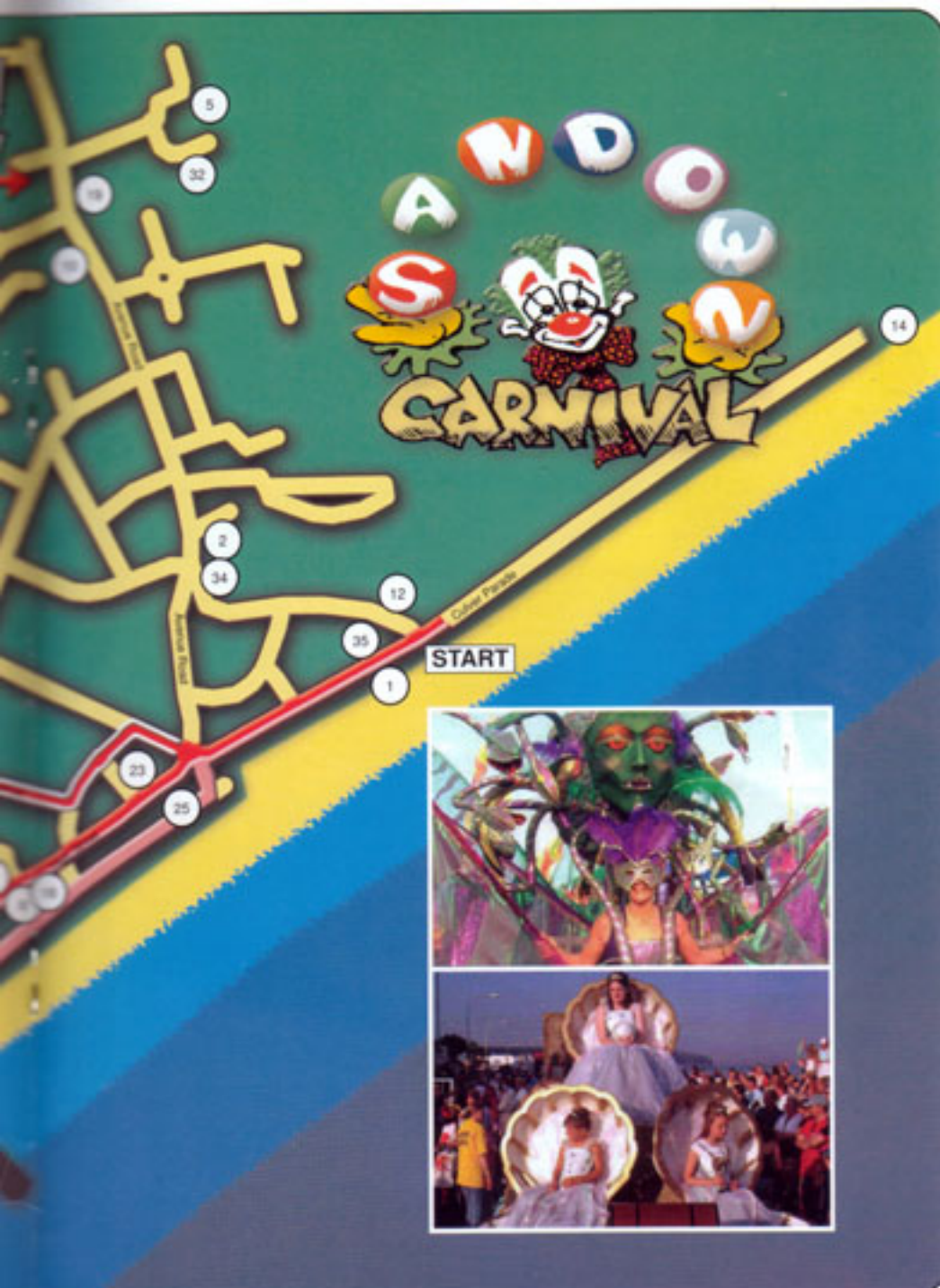

The route sets off along Culver Parade where all the floats, queens, organisations, bands and people in fancy dress meet and get judged. It then proceeds up the High Street, taking a right into Royal Crescent. It then turns right into Melville Street, then left into Fitzroy Street. Then it turns right into Station Avenue. At the bottom of Station Avenue the procession turns left into Albert Street. Finally it takes the 2nd right into Victoria Road then over the small roundabout and ends up in Culver Parade facing the other way.

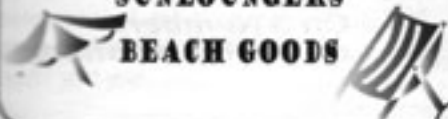
