
BIG LOTTERY



Thanks to funding from the Big Lottery Sandown Carnival Association has been able to provide opportunities for the Young People of the Island to get involved in Carnival and other events.

This year the project has funded a group of young people in the design and making of ten individual costumes and 2 individual costumes all of which will be worn at Sandown carnivals. Many young people have had the opportunity to visit and perform at mainland carnivals and events including the Opening of the first UK Carnival centre in Luton.

Other workshops funded through the lottery project have included performance and dance. The purchase of the Islands first Eco sound systems has supported lots of schools and community groups by providing them with sound to perform to at the carnivals. Masquerade Mondays will also continue every Monday this summer at Eastern Gardens from 2pm – 4pm. The event allows young people to show off skills that they have learnt at other lottery funded projects.


