
In addition to our summer events we also look forward each year to our November Fireworks celebrations (this year held on Saturday 2nd November) and Christmas Eve Fun Day.







### PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Restrictions will be in place across the majority of the carnival route (see centre pages) and will be clearly signed in accordance with IW Council requirements. Traffic cones will also be deployed. These restrictions enable the procession to proceed unhindered and to ensure crowd safety.

All parking restrictions will be strictly enforced, including towing away where necessary.

### **CAR PARKS**

Public car parks are marked on the route map (see centre pages) but remember that these will get very busy and that usual parking terms & conditions still apply. See the information boards in the car parks for details.

### **ROAD CLOSURES**

Prior to and during Carnival processions, various roads around the town will be closed for safety purposes. The main closure affects the High Street along almost its entire length, Culver Parade and The Esplanade. However other roads are also affected for shorter periods - refer to the centre pages for route details.

### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Buses and trains will operate a normal timetable throughout the day. Buses will divert along Broadway during road closures instead of coming into the town centre. Follow @SouthernVectis on Twitter for regular travel updates throughout the day.


