# CAR PARKS are marked on the Route Map (centre pages) but remember that these will become very busy and that usual parking terms and conditions will still apply. The largest car parks most likely to have space include: The

Heights, Fort Street, Sandown Zoo, Yaverland.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS will be in place across the majority of the carnival route and will be clearly signed in accordance with IW Council requirements. Traffic cones and prohibition notices will be displayed. These restrictions allow the procession to proceed unhindered and to help ensure spectator safety.

ALL parking restrictions will be strictly enforced, involving towing away where necessary.

ROAD CLOSURES - prior to and during the procession, various roads around the town will be closed for safety purposes. The main closure affects the High Street along almost its entire length, Culver Parade and The Esplanade. However, other roads are also affected for shorter periods - refer to the centre pages for route details - between approx. 5:00pm and 9:00pm.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT operators will run a normal timetable throughout the day. Buses will divert along Broadway during road closures instead of coming into the town centre (between approx. 6:30pm and 8:30pm). Therefore, during these times, for buses in the Ryde direction walk to the roundabout by Moreys / Esso. For buses in the Newport/Shanklin direction, walk to The Heights.

Those with **MOBILITY ISSUES** should arrive early and park sensibly and safely.
